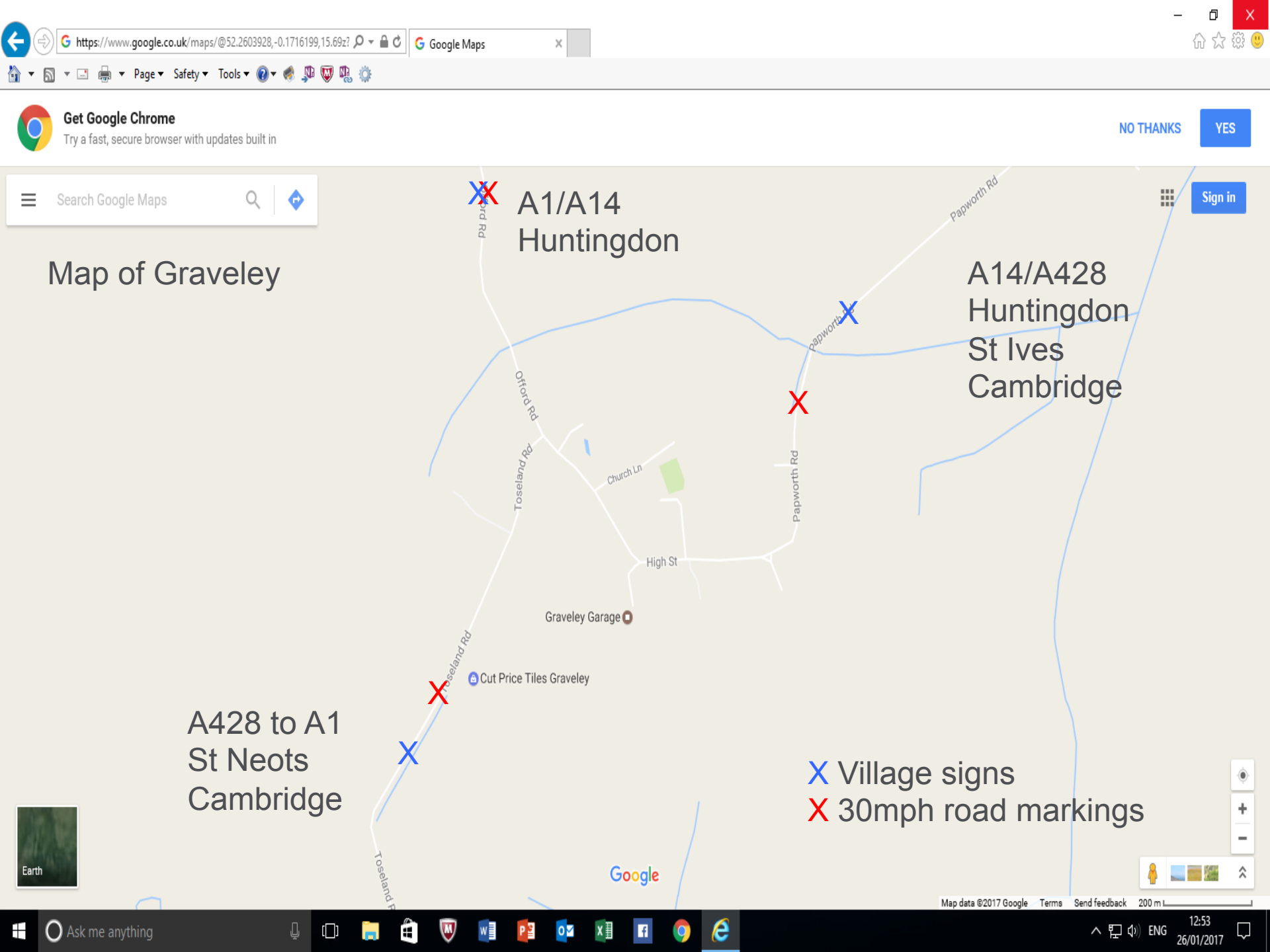

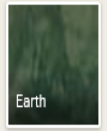

# Graveley Speed Calming Survey & Proposal for Funding

- ◆ Purpose to apply some simple low cost speed calming measures at all entrance points to village & through the village:
- ◆ Current situation in Graveley
  - ◆ Poor village signage identifying it's a village.
  - ◆ No consistency of 30mph speed limit and poor signage.
  - ◆ Road markings not all legible throughout the village.
  - ◆ Due to the village having limited pavements we have a risk too :-
    - ◆ - Pedestrians & young children, during peak times.
    - ◆ - Young children in the mornings & evenings meeting school buses
    - ◆ - The risks are still high at weekends, dog walkers etc.



# Graveley Speed Calming Survey & Proposal for Funding

- ◆ Purpose to apply some simple low cost speed calming measures at all entrance points to village & through the village:
- ◆ Current situation in Graveley
  - ◆ - Graveley is a shortcut for most commuters due traffic on the A14/A428
  - ◆ - This can result in higher volumes
  - ◆ - We expect the situation to get worse over the next few years, while construction work is carried out on the A14 & the A428

# Graveley Speed Calming Survey & Proposal for Funding

- ◆ Proposal for funding is for new Glasdon signage at the three entry points to the village to provide consistency and clear speed restrictions. This should also include updating current 30 signs on the road markings (See below examples).





# Graveley Speed Calming Survey & Proposal for Funding

- ◆ Funding for a SID speed indication display that can be moved to temporary locations throughout the village.
- ◆ We would also like this to provide data monitoring, so we can communicate the results to residence of Graveley.



# Graveley Speed Calming Survey & Proposal for Funding

- ◆ Other considerations that Graveley Parish Council would like to propose, either funded or not:
- ◆ Complete review of the current road markings with a view to supporting the narrowing of the road by removing the centre white lines.
- ◆ Apply new white lines at the edges of the road, also creating some visual chicanes at relative points on the road.
- ◆ This has been successful in surrounding villages.
