Barbecues and bonfires

Never leave your barbecue or bonfire X unattended. Put your bonfire out with a hosepipe if you have to leave it.

Empty used ash onto bare garden soil, not your bin.

Never barbecue or bonfire near trees, fences or sheds.

Always keep a bucket of water or hosepipe nearby.

Cigarettes

Never throw cigarettes onto grass, vegetation or wooden decking.

Always fully extinguish cigarettes and matches.

Gas cylinders

- Never store gas cylinders under the stairs. They can explode in a fire and block your escape.
 - Always store gas cylinders outside in the shade.





- X Don't store more cylinders than you need.
 - Change gas cylinders outdoors in a well ventilated area. Make sure the tap is off before you change cylinders

Sheds and garages

- Keep petrol, solvents and paints in proper containers and make sure they are clearly marked.
- Never store them near heat sources or flammable rubbish like paper.
- Keep it tidy recycle old papers, packaging and clothes.
